



7. Operation Controls and Functions 7.1 Top Panel




① Input 1~4: The LED will illuminate in blue when selected the source.




① Optical In: These slots are to connect with input source equipments such as DVD/Blue-Ray player for audio input signal sending.

7.2 Left Panel




- ① Power: Press this button to turn on the device or to set it to standby mode. The blue LED on the top panel will illuminate when the device is turn on.
- 2 Input: Press this button to select the input port from 1~4. The blue LED on the top panel will illuminate according to the selection.
- ③ Optical OUT: This slot is where you connect the amplifier or active speaker with optical cable for audio output.
- 4 IR: This is the IR receiver window receiving IR signal from the remote control included with the device.

7.3 Rear Panel



① DC 5V: This slot is where you plug the 5V DC power supply into the unit and connect the adaptor to an AC wall outlet.
