


### Declaration

#### Without Mounting Bracket

Step1 Power on the power adapter that connected to this product.

Step2 When the power is switched on, the LED light (#7) shows green.

#### **Use Mounting Bracket**

**Step1** Put the mounting bracket to the back of the tablet, and tighten the installation screws on the screw holes.

**Step2** Plug the power adapter into the DC in jack (#8 in <u>Product Instruction</u>) at the bottom of the mounting bracket.

### **Insert USB Devices**


